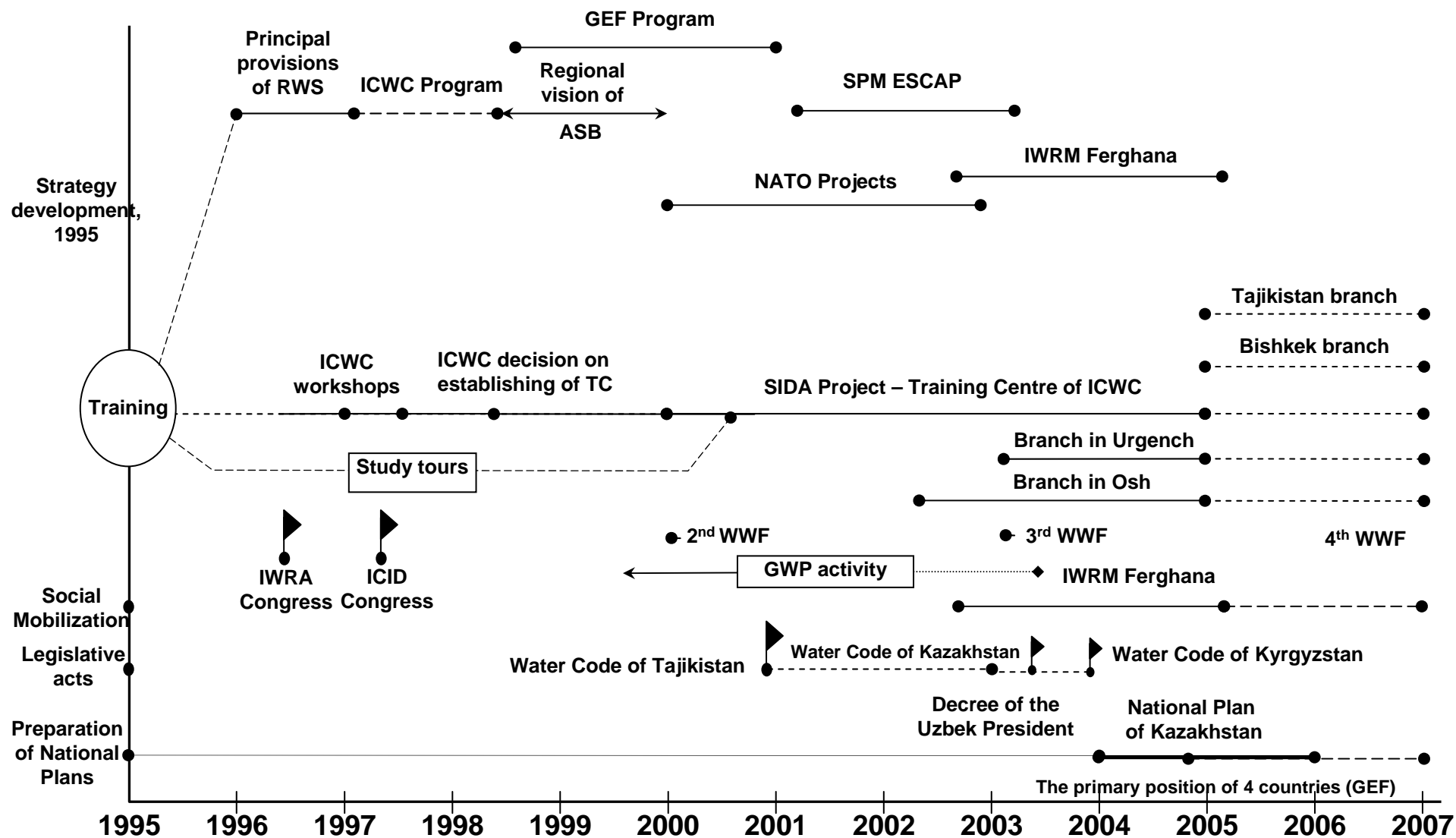

Procedure and Format of Training

The standard interactive form of training:

- preliminary distribution of materials
- organization of discussions by experienced moderators
- developing mutual understanding.



Round table discussion among representatives of different countries and different sectors, "brain storming" to achieve a consensus on interstate and inter-sectoral level.



Joint recommendations are prepared and handed over to ICWC members for further.



Main distinguishing features of our training

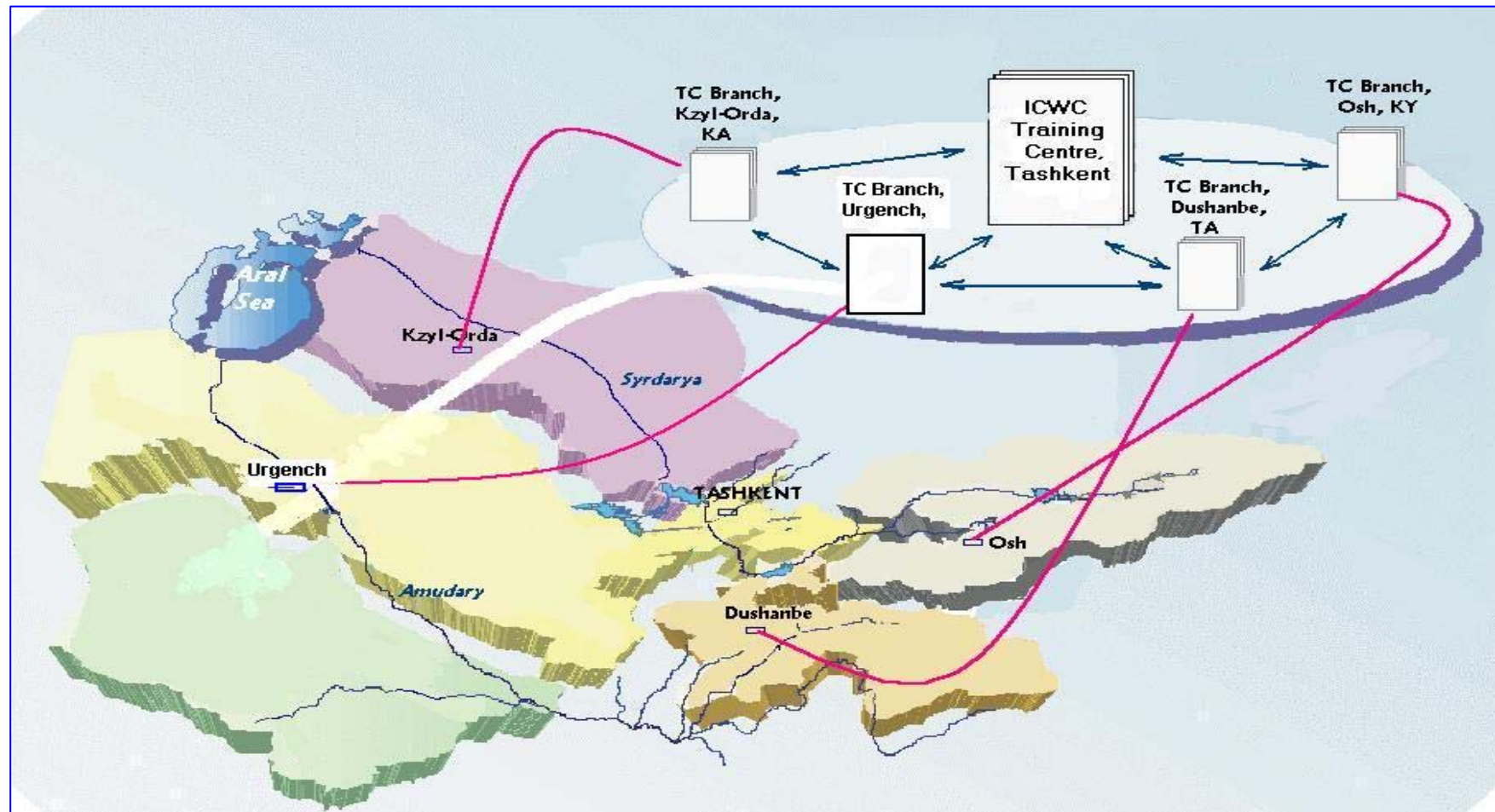
(I)

- **Partner cooperation (McGill; IHE-UNESCO; MRC; IWMI; Bonn, Stuttgart, Montpellier and Semargef Universities);**

Main office:

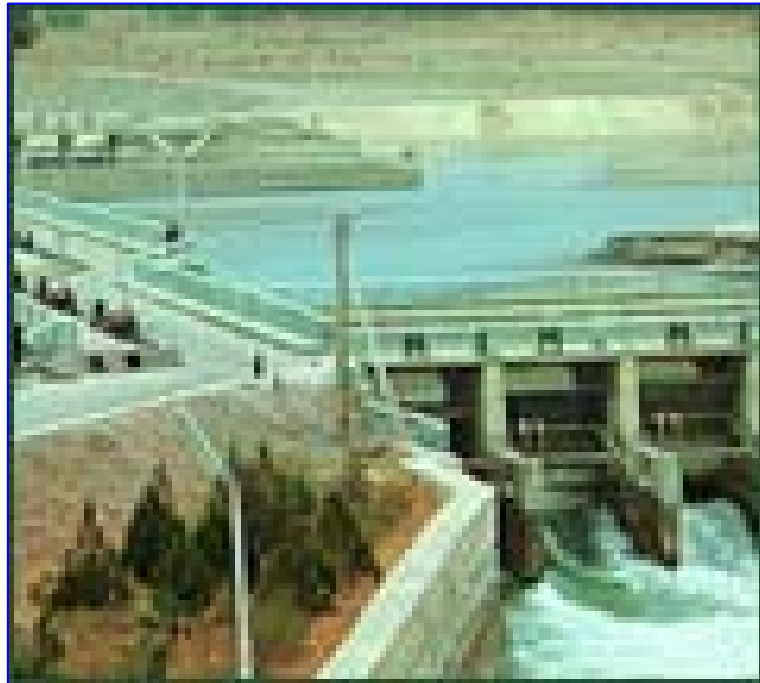
- coordination of regional training activities;

Main distinguishing features of our training

(IY) Thematic approach. Involvement of related sectors.



Main distinguishing features of our training

- **Integrated Water Resource Management:** – more than 600 professionals trained
- **Transboundary Waters: Strategy for Improvement of Regional Cooperation:** – more than 450 professionals trained
- **International and National Water Law and Policy:** – more than 300 professionals trained
- **Improvement of Irrigated Agriculture:** – more than 250 professionals trained
- **Role of public participation in IWRM:** – more than 90 professionals trained
- **Gender aspects of IWRM:** – more than 60 professionals trained
- **Water and Education:** – more than 180 professionals trained

More than 2000 participants and about 250 trainers are trained

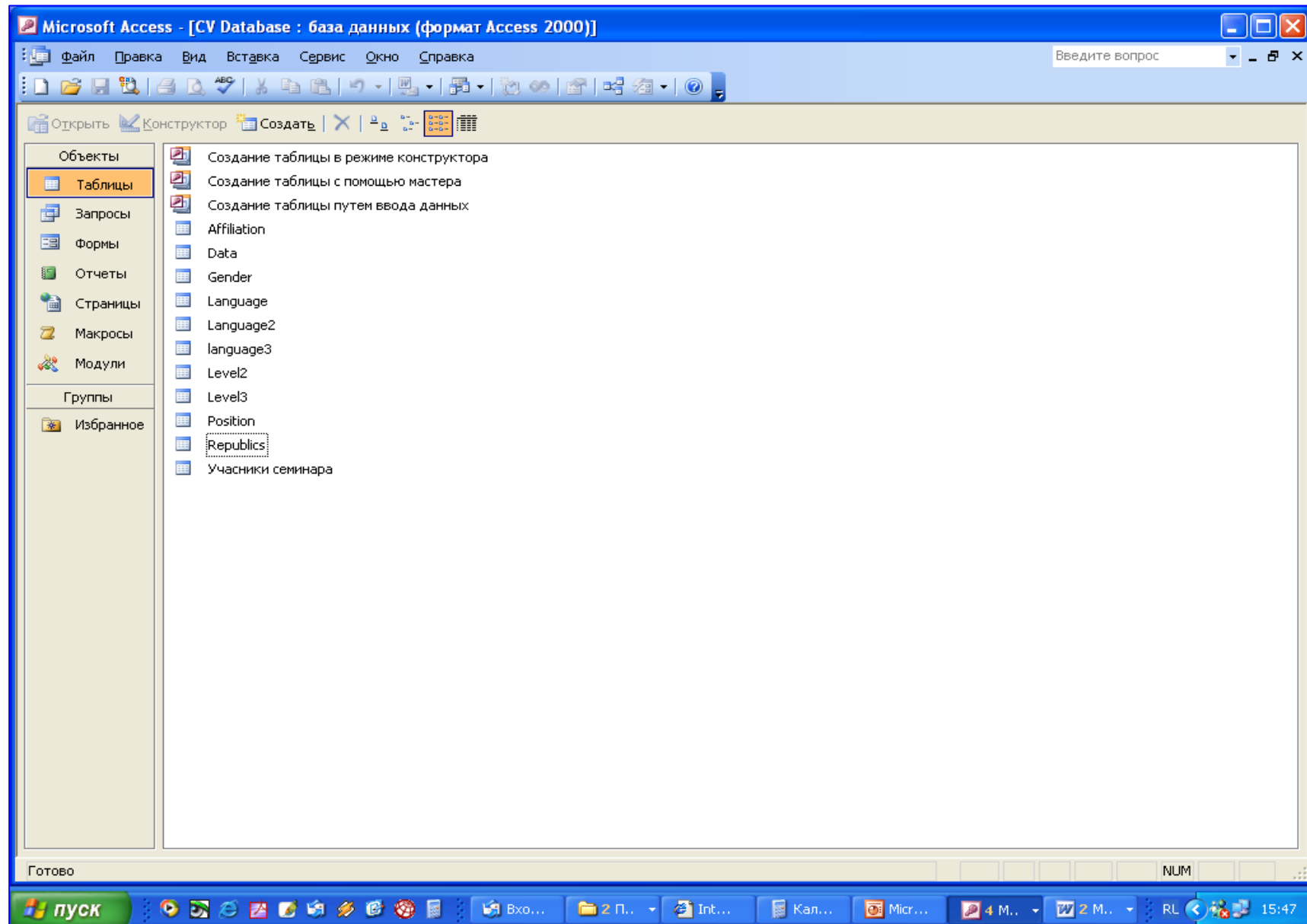

- **IWRM in Central Asia, Legislative acts;**
